Dear Parents and Carers,

Many of you have recognised the challenge of trying to ensure our school continues to run as normally as possible; the responsibility of doing this whilst keeping your children, staff and all families safe and well. We are determined to stay open for the sake of our pupils emotional and academic development. It has been a joy to see children back with their class mates, playing and learning together.

We have risk assessed, read and implemented guidance in a way that we think matches our Beech Green ethos – we put children first and serve our community. However, we are concerned about groups of people waiting at the start and end of every day. We don't want to impose a staggered system, but if this doesn't improve by Monday 21st September we will start to allocate specific pick up times.

Front gate

Please do not arrive **until after 8:40am**; teachers have set up work to help children practice subject knowledge in the morning, **lessons do not start until 9:10am**

Please do not arrive to collect your child until after 3:20pm, children in KS2 are working until 3:40pm

Side gate

Please do not arrive **until after 8:50am**; teachers have set up work to help children practice subject knowledge in the morning, **lessons do not start until 9:10am**

Please do not arrive to collect your child until after 3:10pm, children in KS1 are working until 3:30pm

Some families have started to use the side gate to drop and collect their Reception and KS1 children first, we understand that this makes it easier for you; **please**, **please** arrive after 3:20pm so that you do not have to wait outside Year 6.

Thank you for sticking to the one-person rule, that has helped.

Symptoms, tests and home learning

The DFE guidance states that we may need to send a bubble (year group) home to isolate for 14 days if we have a **confirmed positive** test result.
