

Changes to the Test and Trace support payment for parents

Claiming financial support under the Test and Trace Support Payment scheme – updated 22nd March 21 Parents and carers of children who have been advised to self-isolate by their education setting or by NHS Test and Trace are now able to apply for a <u>Test and Trace Support Payment</u> or discretionary payment of £500, if they meet the eligibility criteria. The extension of the Test and Trace Support Payment scheme, which is administered by district and unitary local authorities in England, ensures that parents receive the financial support they need if they are unable to attend work due to childcare responsibilities. Parents and carers should apply to their local authority to receive a payment and can check if they meet the criteria at the government link above.
