Increasing COVID Cases

Thank you all for your support continuing the one-way system. We know it is an inconvenience, but it makes such a difference to the amount of congestion, especially at the top gate. We have mostly continued with Year group bubbles, with the exception of after school clubs and some teaching groups. Staff are wearing masks in corridors and we have not sat together in the staff room for almost two years now! Regular hand washing has been maintained and all the windows are open. The numbers around Gloucestershire are especially high: this has been reflected in the number of positive cases we have at school, even since we have returned from half term.

The children and staff at Beech Green have once again responded brilliantly. The teaching staff have all demonstrated commitment and flexibility to keep year groups in school. The children have continued to work hard, showing resilience and enthusiasm for their learning. We aim to not let the staff shortages impact on their education whilst doing everything we can to keep everyone as safe as possible. Your support and excellent communication mean a lot, so please keep doing everything you can to help.


FABG Events - This Saturday!
