Lateral Flow Device (LFD) Testing for Primary Age Children

Government guidance to schools has been updated on 29th October 2021 and we are now told LFD testing is suitable for children under 11 years. (Previously we had been told to say it was not, but apparently it is now is a good idea to regularly test.) Lateral flow tests are regarded as 92% accurate, but if you have symptoms then you should still book and take a PCR test please.

We are now to encourage parents to be regularly testing as lateral flow tests are regarded as 92% accurate. Anyone can get LFD test kits from pharmacies; once we are able to order extra we hope to have some in school too for those who may need them. Please do not ask at the moment, as we don't have enough to hand out.

Please, please, if your child has a cough or any symptom then do not send them into school as it will save us time having to send them straight back home. You will understand we are paddling fast to keep up with everything, as was outlined in the ParentMail sent home yesterday.
