Dear Parents and Carers,




The teaching staff are also all learning. We regularly observe each other's lessons to identify what is or isn't working. All our leaders collect and analyse evidence, we are constantly finding ways to improve our work, which impacts on positive learning experiences and progress for our pupils. Mrs Thorne and Mrs Ballinger have found examples of how manipulatives (resources) are used in maths. I thought it might be helpful to share this with you, your child might be able to explain what they have done in class. It doesn't matter if they can't tell you, learning is a slow process and explaining something out of context is difficult.



In Reception

The Mastering Number approach supports children in creating images in their mind. This photo shows a lesson where children took a photo of the image with their mind and then discussed how to recreate it.






Year 1


Each example was modelled on the board the children were recreated it with their equipment and recorded the number pairs that go together to make 11, this allowed them to develop confidence.
