#### **School Council News**

## **Caterlink Price Increase**

Advance warning that a school meal price will be £2.36 from September. Whilst we are all currently experiencing significant food inflation, this price is guaranteed to the 31st March 2023.

#### Current Y2 – note that you start paying for dinners in Y3 – Are you entitled to FSM?

If your child is moving from Y2 to Y3 in September, then you will be used to getting a free universal KS1 dinner, but from September you will need to start paying £2.36 per day, which needs to be available on ParentPay before you request a meal.

If you think you may be entitled to Free School Meals (FSM), but have never got around to claiming it, then this is the time to login and make sure you continue to get a FSM.

Visit www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals now, to check if you are entitled.

# <u>Current Y6 – money on ParentPay</u>

The current Y6 need to note that any money you have left on your ParentPay account does **not** carry over to secondary school, so only pay the dinner money you will need for meals at Beech Green until the end of term.

## Free Vouchers, Food Hampers and Activities during the summer

A bit to read below on how you can claim free food or activities during the summer; there is something for everyone, so do take a moment to read the following...

## <u>Information on the Holiday FSM voucher scheme for the summer period</u>

This summer holiday, Gloucestershire County Council (GCC) is providing vouchers to parents who have signed up to their Holiday Free School Meals (FSM) scheme. These vouchers are provided by GCC as part of its commitment to 'no child goes hungry'.

Parents who are registered will receive £15 per eligible child, per week. For the summer holiday, GCC will be providing 2 weeks' worth of vouchers, as they did in the previous summer holiday. The scheme is eligible for children aged 4-16 years old.

Parents who have signed up previously do not need to re-register, they will have already been included. For those parents who have already signed up, if more of your children have become entitled to free school meals since you applied, then please contact <a href="mailto:childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk">childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk</a> so they can update your account, as this not an automatic process.

Applications for Holiday Free School Meal Vouchers for the summer holiday period is now open until the midday on the 12 July. Voucher emails will be sent out between 13 and 14 July. Please check your junk/spam email folders during this period as sometimes the vouchers end up there.
