Eating School Dinners - I've been eating a school dinner every day since the start of term and I have to report that I've been really impressed by the quality of food being prepared and served. A number of teachers, as well as me, regularly sit and eat with the children and we, along with the lunch time supervisors, are trying hard to help them to master using a knife and fork so the children can cut up and eat their food properly. We're also trying to help them remember their table manners such as not talking with their mouths full or throwing food on the floor. Many of our children have learnt these basic skills but we're concerned that more and more children don't know how to use a knife and fork properly and so we would really appreciate your support with this at home - thank you in anticipation of your help with this important issue.

School Trips... how to pay... it's a new way!

Important changes – please read below

Back in June we notified parents via the school newsletter that we intend to change the way we take payments for school trips, as we are working towards becoming a cashless school office.

This academic year we will not be taking cheque or cash payments for school trips via the school office. Payments will instead be made online via ParentPay.

To pay for trips parents/carers will need to logon to their child's ParentPay account (if you cannot remember your username or password then please come and ask us in the school office). You will then need to select the correct item to pay against, e.g. Y3 Stone Age Trip. It is essential that parents/carers select the correct item to pay for at this stage, making make sure you don't accidentally pick up and put the money into school dinners by mistake! You can of course select to top up your school dinner fund as well at the same time and add that to your basket as well.

Having selected the correct item, e.g. Y3 Stone Age Trip, you will be asked to pay online, like any other online shop or payment facility. It's really easy.

If you need to pay by cash at PayPoint, then you will need to come to collect a separate bar coded letter. The one you already have is for dinners only and each item will have a bar code specific to it. Again, if you use the bar code you might already have then that money would go to your child's dinner money account and not the trip, by mistake!

Any problems during this transition period, then please pop in to the office and we will gladly help you.

Y3 parents are the first to use this new facility with their school trip coming up, so good luck to them and thank you all for your support.

money balance at least weekly. The cost is £2.20 (£11 per week). There is zero tolerance towards dinner debt, so please send a packed lunch if you don't have funds available. If you are not sure how it works then please come and ask us in the school office.

Medicines in School

Just a reminder that we are happy to administer **prescribed** medicine to your child if:

- ◆ You include clear instructions, in writing, indicating your permission for a member of staff to do so. Instructions must include the type of medicine, dosage and timing. We cannot accept any responsibility for the administering of medicine where the timing of the dose is crucial or where some medical/technical knowledge is required.
- ◆ You understand it will ultimately remain the child's responsibility to come to a member of staff to receive the medication, and to collect it at the end of the day. If you are not happy with this arrangement you should come in to school to administer the medicine.
- ◆ Please note that we can only administer **prescribed** medicines.

While we want to encourage good attendance, please do not send your child into school if they are clearly ill, e.g. taking antibiotics.

We have already had reports of nits in class. Please check your childrens' hair and treat if necessary. You can now obtain the medication free, by taking your child to a chemist that takes part in the NHS Minor Ailment Service (Boots in Quedgeley do). They will ask for the child's date of birth and the name of their Doctor's surgery and can then issue medication for free as a prescription as long as your surgery is registered to take part.
