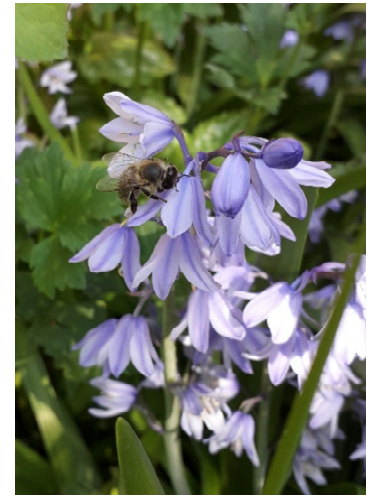
Beech Green Photography Competition
