Do you have a child born between 1st September 2017 and 31st August 2018?

RECEPTION 2022 IMPORTANT REMINDER... If you do have a child born between 1st September 2017 and 31st August 2018, then your child is due to start primary school September 2022 and you need to have applied for a school place. Everyone needs to apply, even if you already have an older sibling already attending Beech Green.

The online application facility is the preferred method for most parents as it allows you to receive an email on allocation day, rather than a letter. However, should you be unable to use it, you can download a paper application form available in the Related Documents column and return this to Gloucestershire County Council, who issue primary school places, by the closing date of 15 January 2022. It is extremely important that you submit your application by Midnight, 15 January 2022.
