Dear Parents and Carers,

Over the next few weeks we are cautiously removing some of the COVID measures put in place almost two years ago. The constant vigilance and monitoring will continue, as will ventilation and hand washing. Adults will remain in bubble groups, but we will gradually move towards whole school mixing, at break times for pupils outside.

All being well, children can start to ride their bike or scooter to school from Monday 7th February, they can once again be stored in the bike and scooter rack on the front playground. Children will need to walk their wheels to the storage shed, locks are advised.

We have also decided to invite you to use any gate in any direction! You can still walk round the building of course finding a route that works for you, but do ask if you're not sure. The end of the day is much busier, congestion is most likely at the top gate, please do continue to use the carpark gate. Friday afternoons are particularly hectic; gate times will remain the same (8.40 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. to arrive; collection will be 3.00 p.m. for Reception children and 3.10 p.m. to 3.30 p.m. for the rest of the school) Arrive towards the end of these slots, if you want to avoid crowds of people.

Finally, please continue to tell us if you or your child has symptoms and/or a positive LFD/PCR test. We are responsible for a large community of people; our duty of care to pupils, staff, you and your family remains.
