
Brigade Uniform Ordering

Have you heard about the new Quedgeley Community Pantry being set-up by Quedgeley Town Council?

Community food pantries help people access affordable and healthy food, toiletries, and household items. They work on a membership basis, allowing people to sign up and go for a shop-like experience. This means they can go to the pantry and choose which items they want and need, giving people more independence and tackling the stigma.

The pantry will be stocked using donations from local stores and individuals, and further subsidised using funds donated or arranged by Quedgeley Town Council.

As this is a community project, that is due to open on Wednesday 13th March 2024, we are holding a food drive, hoping for donations of non-perishable items from our

This food drive will run at school during the week of Monday February 26th to Friday 1st March, and the Community Pantry will be grateful for anything you are able to donate.
